What is e-Giving?

E-Giving is an automatic funds transfer program that allows you to give without writing a check or using cash.

How does it work?

With your permission, MPB automatically transfers the amount you specify from your checking or savings account at any financial institution, directly to the church. We can do this weekly, monthly, quarterly or annually, whichever you choose.

Is it safe?

Very safe. In fact, it's actually safer than writing a check because there is no paper lost or stolen. PLUS, your personal identity is protected through the secure transaction.

What are the benefits?

It saves you time by automatically deducting your giving: There is no more scrambling to write the check in time.

It simplifies your life by making giving convenient and consistent. It happens automatically and you don't need to worry about forgetting.

It supports the church. As a member, you are faithfully providing financial means to support MPB consistently throughout the year.
